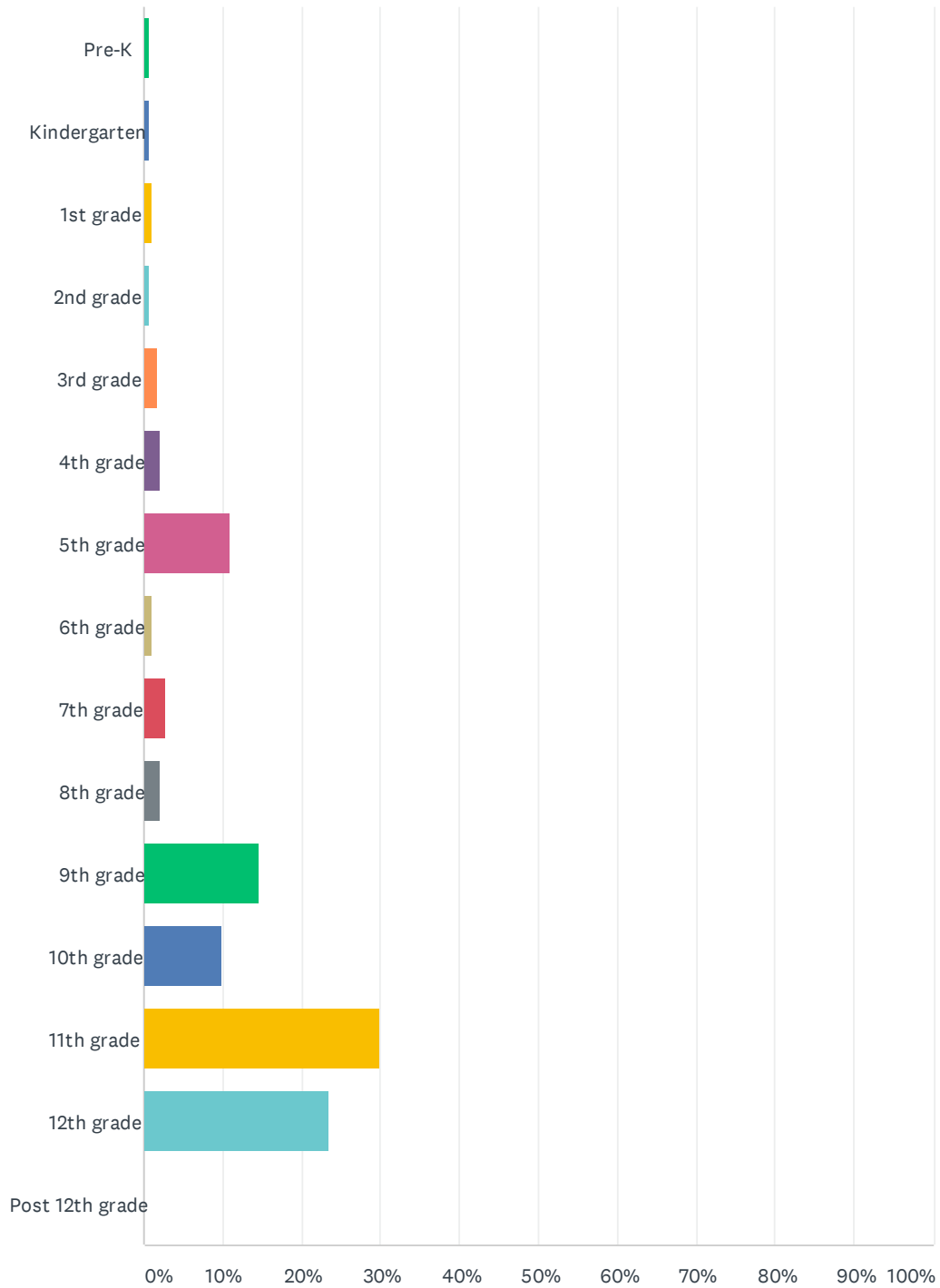


Q1 What grade are you in this school year?

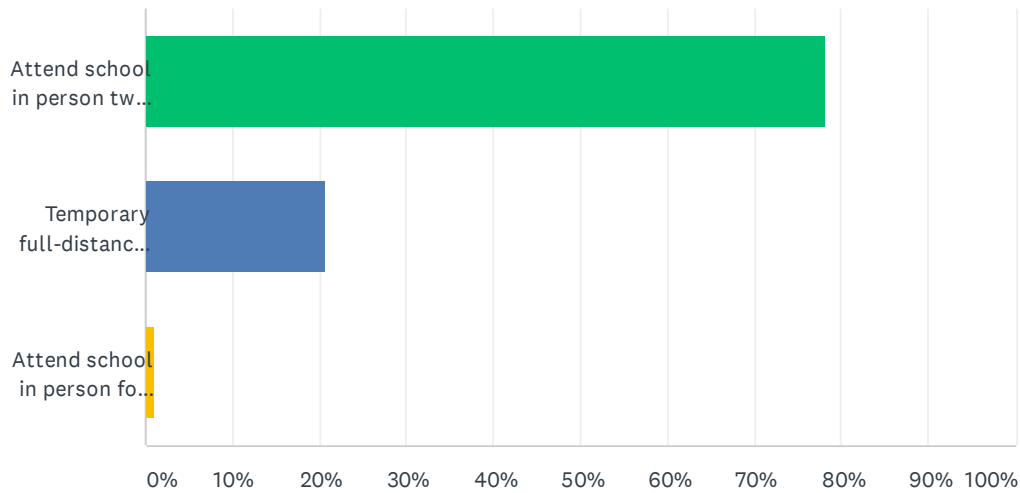

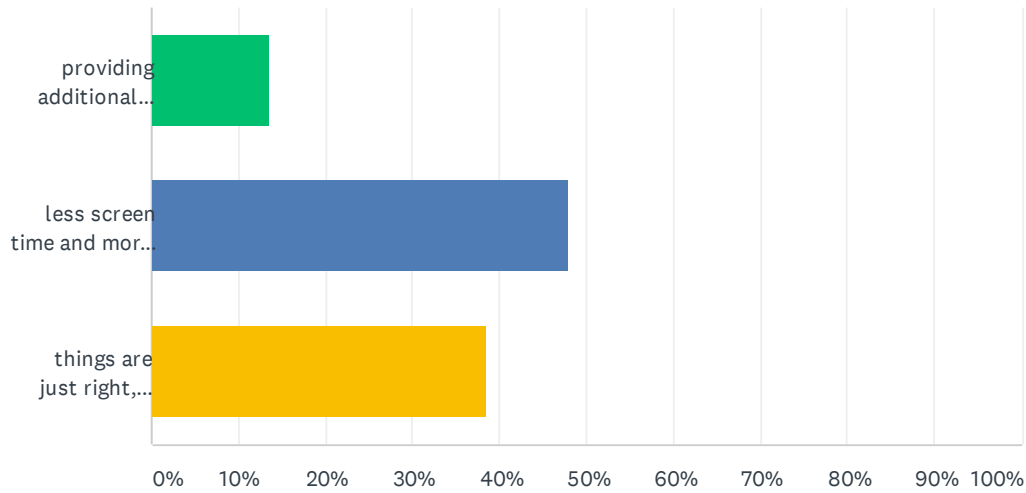

Q8 The school could best support me when I am learning at home by

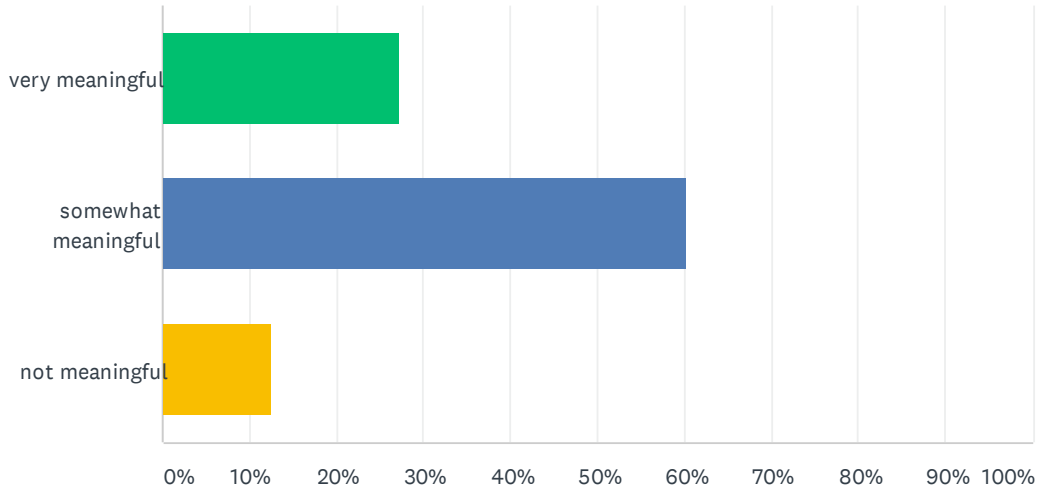

Q9 How meaningful is the current independent work that you are assigned?

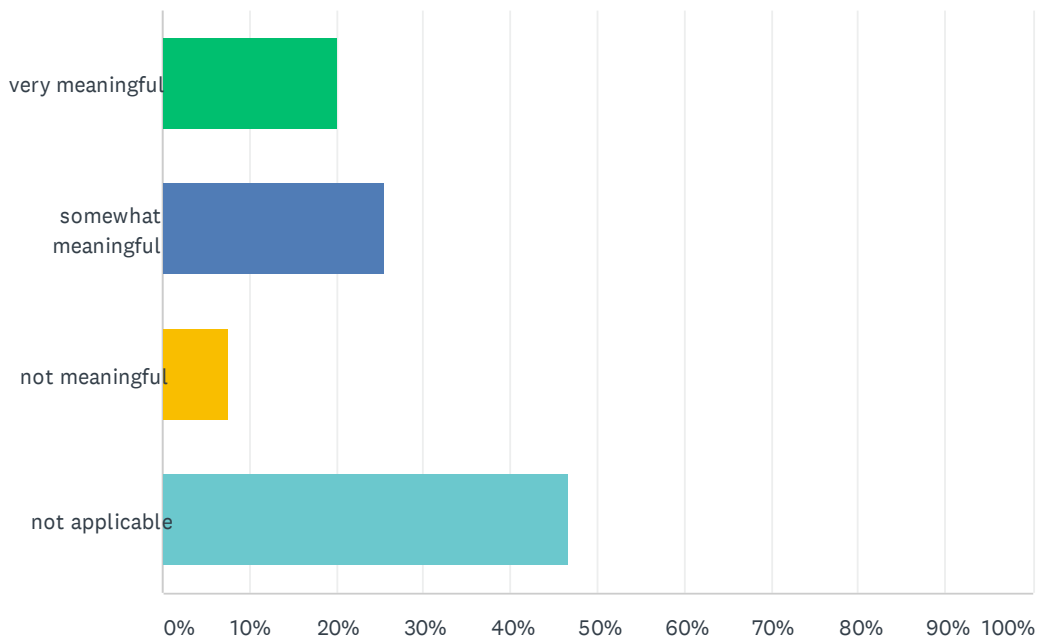

Q10 How meaningful have the supports provided by both paraprofessionals and tutors been for you?

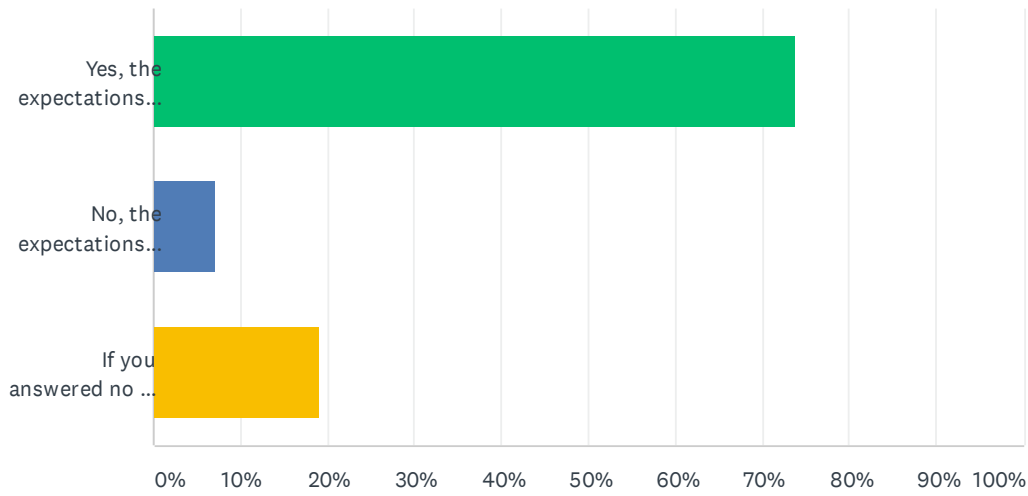

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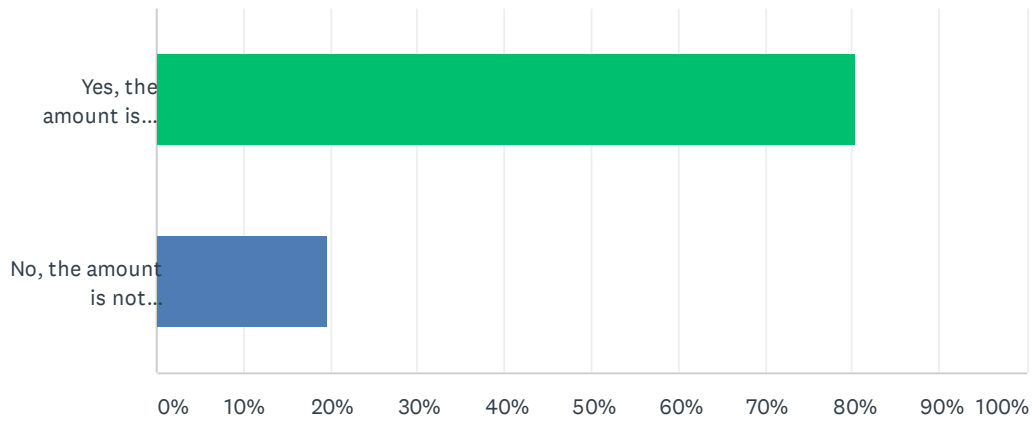

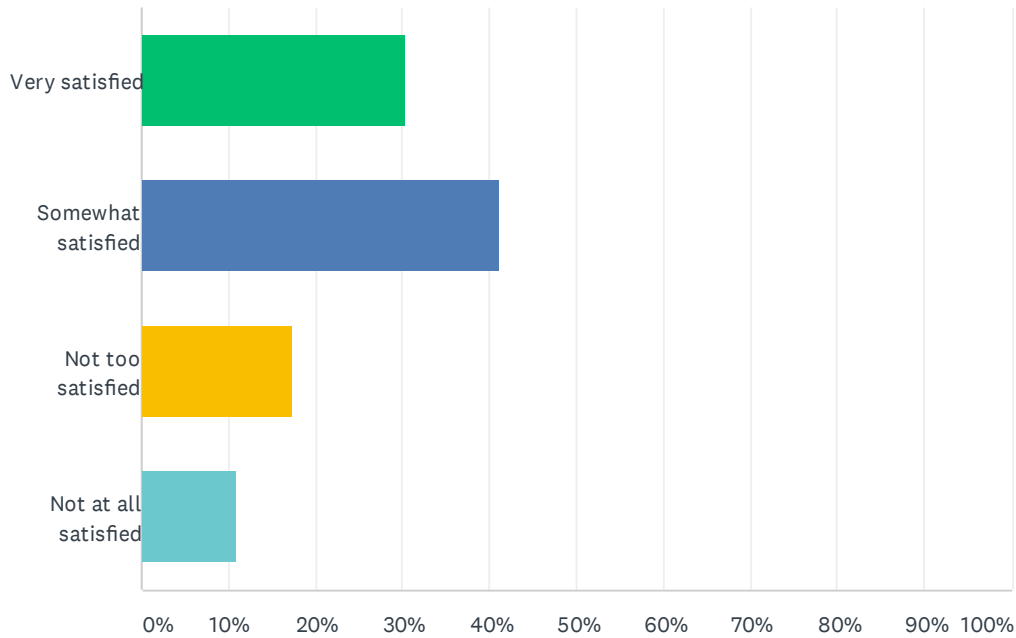

Q13 If you are not learning from home 5 days a week please skip this question. Overall, how satisfied are you, if at all, with the way learning in the temporary full distance model is going this year?

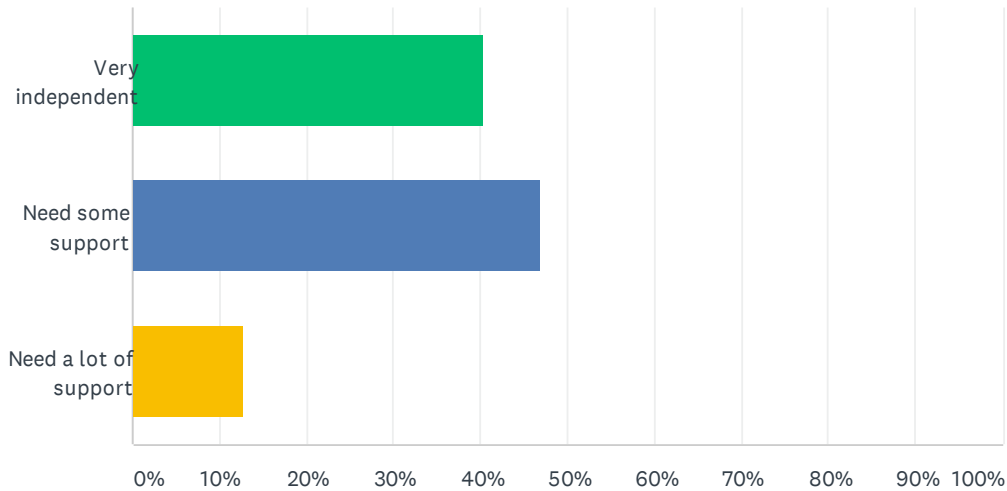

Q14 If you are not learning from home 5 days a week please skip this question. In general, at what level of independence are you completing your school assignments during temporary full distance learning?

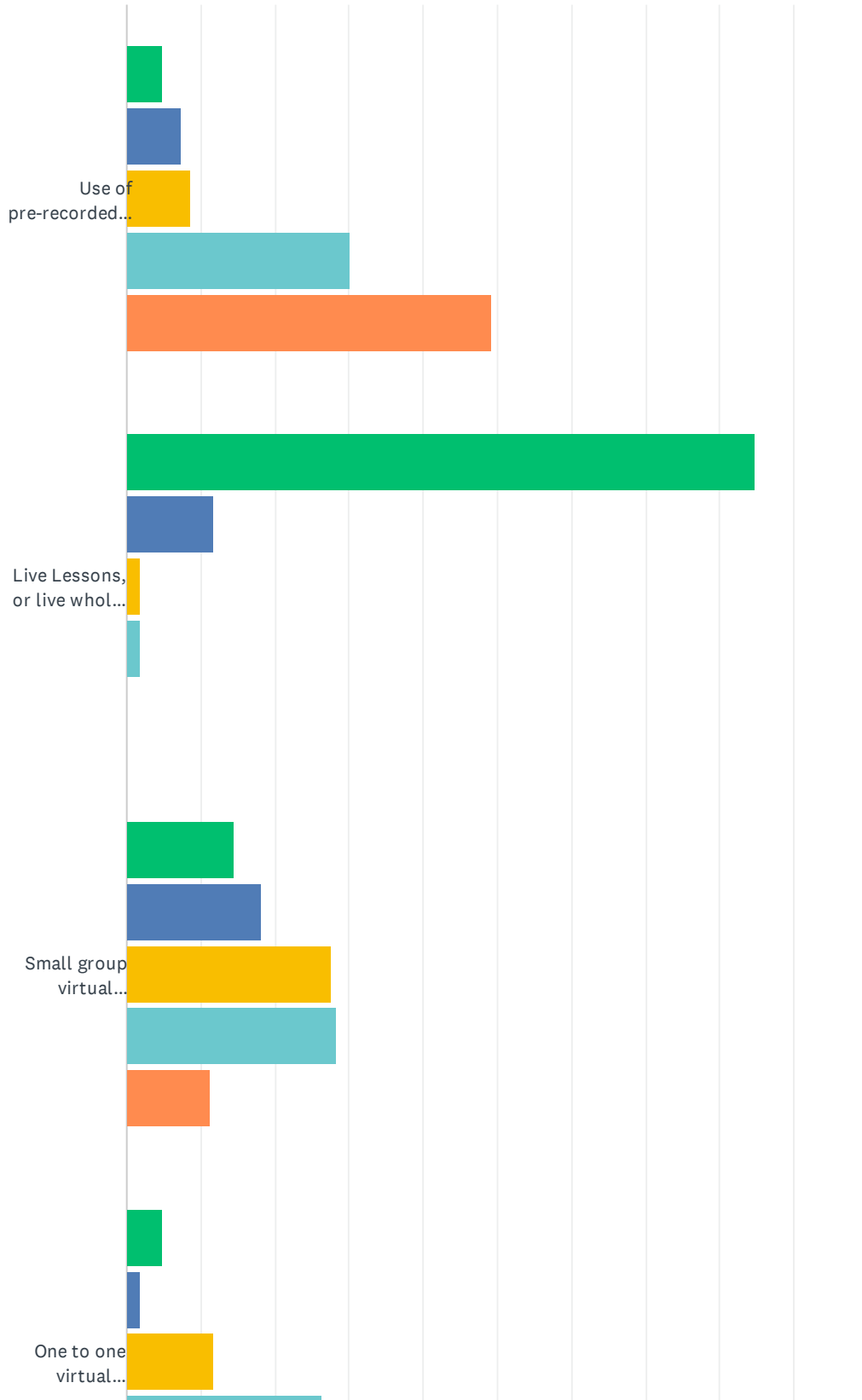

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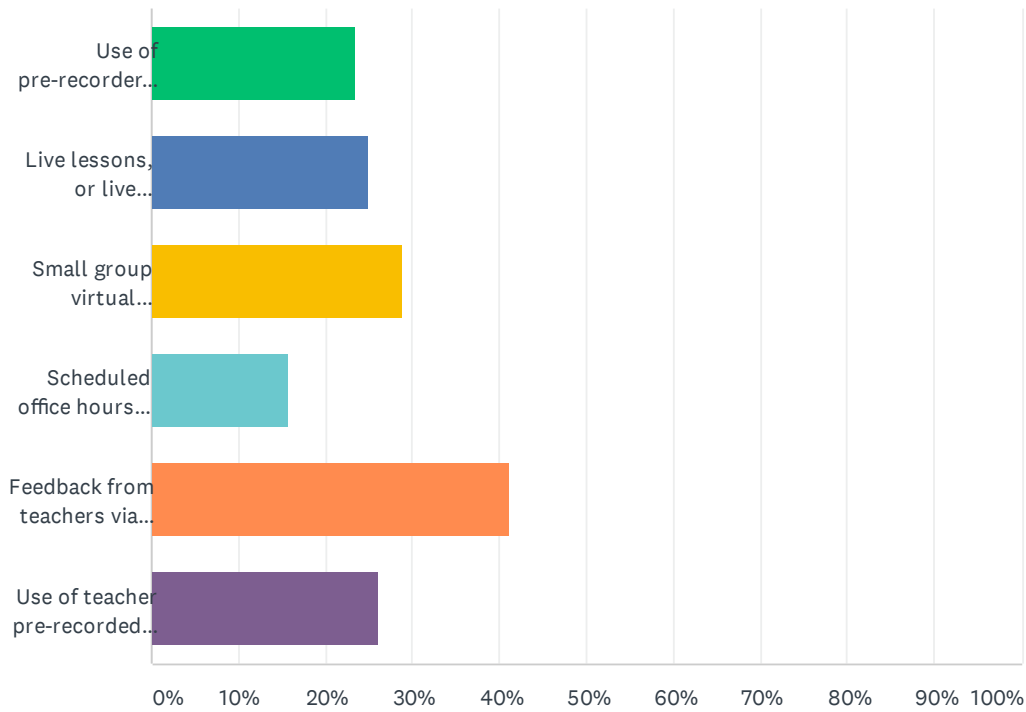

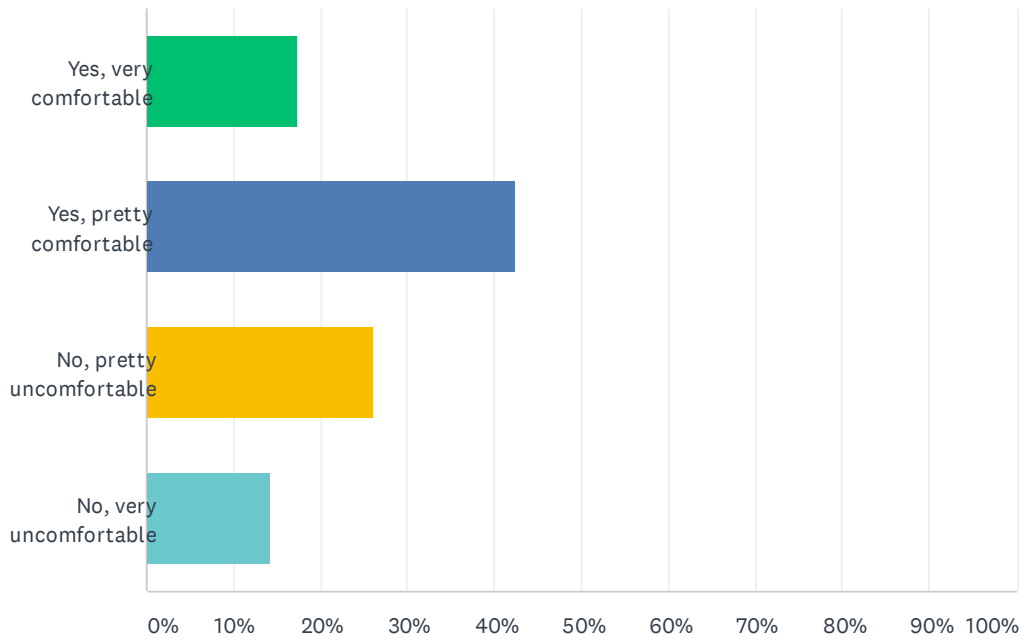

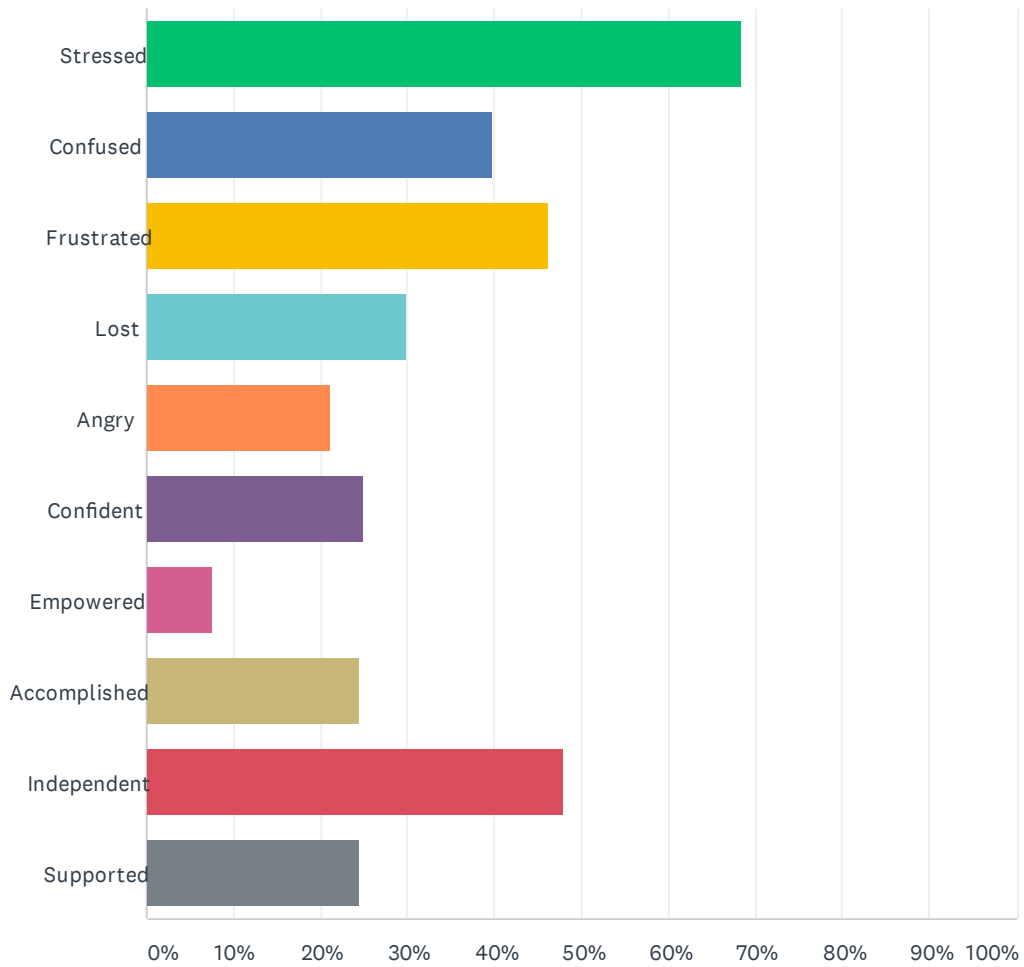

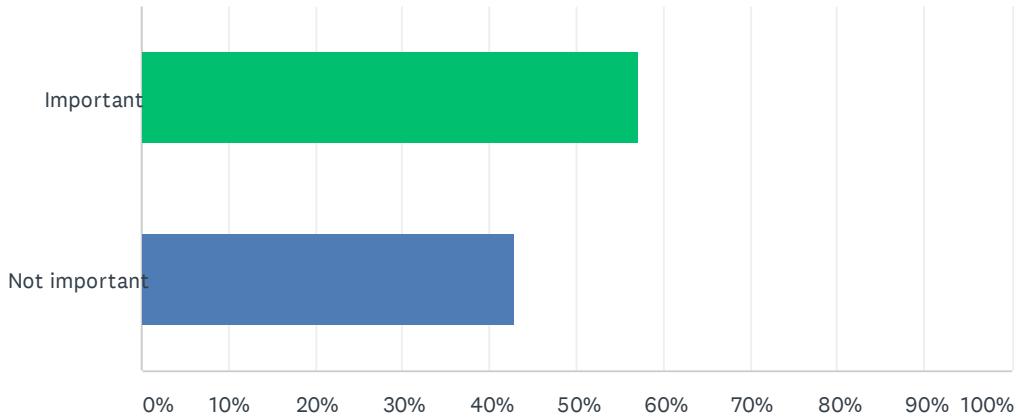

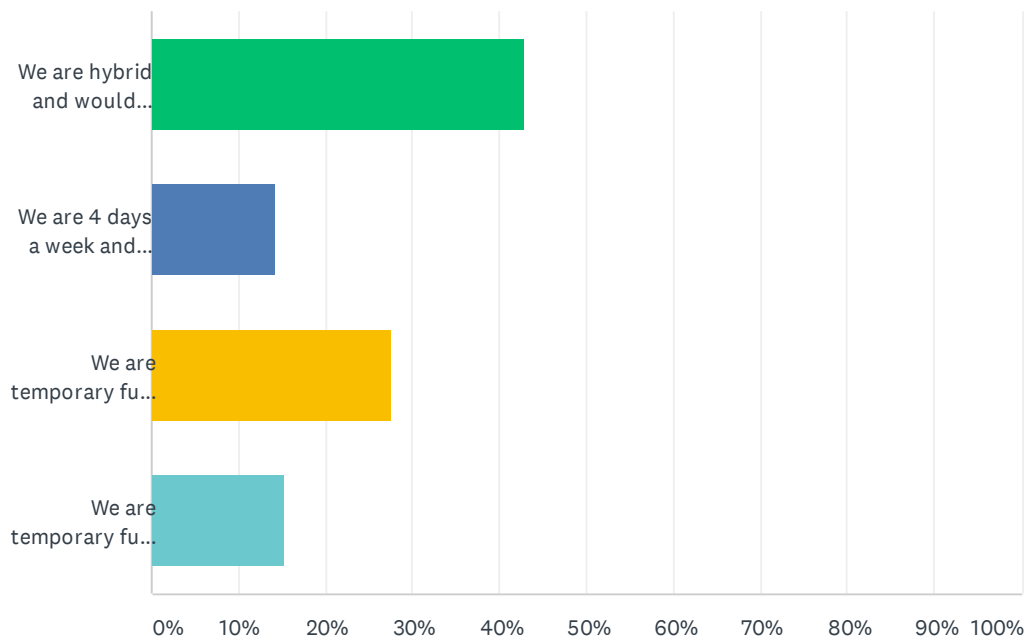
