Travel Advisory for Visitors to Connecticut . Executive Order Regarding Travel: Pursuant to Governor Lamont's Executive Order No. 9C, anyone traveling into Connecticut from a state with a positive case rate higher than 10 per 100,000 residents, or higher than a 10% test positivity rate over a 7-day rolling average, or from a country for which the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC ...

Self-Quarantine for Affected Travelers: All Affected Travelers shall self-quarantine for a period of 14 days on their return to CT if they have spent 24 hours or more in an affected state. See updated list of Affected States on the Travel Advisory Website.

Testing Alternative: An Affected Traveler is exempt from the self-quarantine requirement if they have a COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to returning to CT, or at any time following their return to CT, and the PCR test result is negative.

-Only PCR tests shall be accepted.

-The Affected Traveler must remain in self-quarantine while awaiting the test results and until a negative test result is submitted to the State of CT.

-Please follow the State requirements for travel forms and submission of negative test results to the State of CT.

-Please contact your child's school nurse if you will be traveling and before your child's return to school.

-Written proof of a negative test result is required for return to school. **This testing alternative applies to the travel advisory only, not to the 14-day self-quarantine recommendations resulting from a close contact situation.**
