I am happy to share that Adobe's revised K – 12 terms, posted yesterday at <https://www.adobe.com/privacy/student-policy.html>, comply with the contractual requirements of Connecticut's student data privacy law ([Connecticut General Statutes §§ 10-234aa through 10-234dd](#)).

This update follows several weeks of productive discussions among the Commission's counsel at the Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Adobe's product and legal teams, and I to identify the gaps between Adobe's previous K – 12 privacy terms and our state law. The new terms address those concerns.
